The 2012 Nero d'Avola Poggionotte is a well-composed and put-together red wine with balanced freshness and neat aromas of cherry, cassis, cola and dark spice. Four months of barrique aging is employed in order to soften the contours of the wine and build intensity. Drink 2014-2018.

The Di Giovanna family consists of Aurelio and Barbara founded this 56-hectare estate with their two sons. They are certified organic growers and oversee product in five separate zones. The Miccina, Gerbino and Paradiso vineyards are from 330 to 470 meters above sea level in Contessa Entellina (Palermo) and the San Giacomo and Fiuminello vineyards are 650 to 780 meters above sea level near Sambuca di Sicilia (Agrigento). Bordeaux consulting oenologist Christophe Ollivier (partner to Denis Dubourdieu) contributes to this project. The wines are truly Sicilian in identity and crafted in a very clean, upfront style.
