

HELIOS GRILLO 830 METRI

Helios Grillo is the flagship white wine of the family, obtained from a mountainside single vineyard at 830 meters above sea level. It expresses notes of wild flowers, citrus and stone fruits. Elegant on the palate, with a fruity, rich texture, and a savory finish. A white wine that reveals complexity and depth over time.

DESCRIPTION

Helios, the greek god of sun, is named after the winery's founder Aurelio Di Giovanna and made by hand from harvest to bottling. Made with 100% Grillo grapes cultivated at 830 meters above sea level, the highest elevation of Grillo in Sicily. It expresses the unique terroir of limestone with ancient marine sediment and the intense Sicilian sun. Helios Grillos is a savory and complex white wine, with an elegant profile and a vibrant, mineral finish.

Aroma An expressive bouquet of citrus, white flowers and stone fruits

Flavour A layered palate of citrus and stone fruits with a beautiful acidic core and a savory finish.
